

Q: How do I know if I should register under the Campus Qualifiers or as part of the Open Qualifiers?

A: If you are a matriculated student from one of our Partnered schools (ITE Central, SMU, NUS, NTU, SIM, SIT, SUTD), you are eligible to take part in either the Campus Qualifiers at your respective school or as part of the Open Qualifiers.

However, if you are a registered student from a non-partnered school, you are only eligible to take part in the Open Qualifiers.

Q: If I take part in the Campus Qualifiers, can I take part in the Open Qualifiers too?

A: No. Any individual may only register once as part of one team and this extends to both Campus and Open Qualifiers (i.e. I am a student from SMU, I choose to register under a team from SMU, I cannot register as part of another team in the Open Qualifiers or as part of another team with 4 SIM students).

Q: Who can I register with in my team?

A: If you are taking part in any of the Campus Qualifiers held by the Partnered schools, you are required to register with matriculated students of the same campus (i.e. I am from SMU and wish to take part in the Campus Qualifiers held by SMU, my team can only consist of SMU students).

However, if you are taking part in the Open Qualifiers, your team members can be registered students from any tertiary level educational institutions (i.e. my team in the Open Qualifiers can include students from SMU/NTU/NUS/SIM/SUTD/SIT/ITE/Junior Colleges/Polytechnics or any other private tertiary education institutions such as MDIS or James Cook University).

Do note that four of your team members must be from the same institute.

Q: How many players can I have in my team?

A: Any team must consist of a minimum of 5 players, but a maximum of 6. Any 5 players of your team's roster may participate in PVP Campus League matches.

Q: Can a player substitute for another player during a game?

A: No. Players can be substituted in between matches but not during a match currently being played. Once a team selects its 5 players to take part in the game, these players must see the match to its completion.

Q: Can I still participate in the inter-campus league or PVP Carnival even after graduation?

A: Yes, you will still be considered a student of your respective schools as long as you were enrolled as a student at the point of your registration.
